Awards are presented for:

Australian Stone:

- Best Commercial Project
- Best Civic Project
- Best Restoration Project
- Best Export Project
- Best Sculpture Project
- Best Residential Project

Imported Stone:*

- Best Commercial
- Best Civic
- Best Residential

* Only ASAA members can enter these categories.

The **entry criteria** for the ASAA Architectural Stone Awards are established by the Australian Institute of Architects and ASAA* as follows:

- An architect must be involved in the project.
- The project must display good design values.
- Entry can be instigated by the architect, stone producer, stone supplier, builder, designer or installer.
- Entrants in the 'Imported Stone' category must be members of the Australian Stone Advisory Association.

Our awards are divided into two categories:

- Best use of Australian Natural Stone
- Best use of Imported Stone

The closing date for entries in the penultimate round of awards is 31/7/2019.
